Mandatory Occurrence Reporting (MOR) is a vital aspect of aviation safety management. Governed by ICAO and AN(HK)O legislation, MOR requires reporting of safety-related incidents to enhance transparency and accountability.

Guidance in CAD 382 outlines the types of occurrences that must be reported and establishes assessment standards for the reporting scheme. By systematically collecting and analyzing data through MOR, organizations can identify trends and areas for improvement.

This proactive approach facilitates the development of safety measures and enhances overall aviation safety. Encouraging a culture of reporting ensures that safety concerns are addressed promptly and effectively, fostering continuous improvement in aviation operations.
