Organisation Designation Approval

Overview

HKAR-183 outlines the framework for Organization Designation Approval (ODA) in Hong Kong. The ODA unit model facilitates the delegation of specific responsibilities from the Director-General to approved organizations.

This legislation ensures that organizations meet established safety and quality standards while maintaining regulatory oversight. Article 101 of AN(HK)O emphasizes the importance of compliance with aviation regulations.

Basic principles of HKAR-183 include ensuring accountability, transparency, and adherence to safety protocols. By granting ODA, regulatory authorities can streamline processes while ensuring that safety remains a top priority. This approach fosters a collaborative environment between regulators and industry stakeholders, enhancing overall aviation safety.
