

## **Certificate Course in Airworthiness**

## Overview

This programme provides comprehensive training in airworthiness, covering key regulatory and operational aspects. Topics include Introduction to Hong Kong Air Legislation, focusing on local and international aviation regulations. Participants will learn about approvals of organisations, including maintenance, ensuring compliance with airworthiness standards.

The course explores airworthiness matters from maintenance personnel responsibilities to aircraft certification processes. Key areas include maintenance procedures, defect reporting, and continued airworthiness management. The programme also culminates in understanding the issue of the Certificate of Airworthiness (C of A), ensuring aircraft meet safety and regulatory requirements.

Ideal for aviation professionals, this certificate enhances expertise in maintaining and certifying aircraft airworthiness in compliance with Hong Kong and global aviation standards.
