

Module: Approval of Aircraft Maintenance Training Organisation (HKAR-147)

Overview

Approval of Aircraft Maintenance Training Organisations (AMTOs) under HKAR-147 is essential for developing qualified personnel in the aviation sector. An HKAR-145 approved maintenance organization requires certifying staff who possess HKAR-66 licenses.

These licenses are categorized into basic and type ratings, ensuring that staff are adequately trained for specific aircraft types. AMTOs provide the necessary training to obtain these licenses, emphasizing both theoretical knowledge and practical skills.

Compliance with HKAR-147 ensures that training programs meet established safety standards and regulatory requirements. By fostering a well-trained workforce, AMTOs contribute significantly to the overall safety and reliability of aircraft maintenance operations.
